

### About our Staff...

Each class offered has a teaching team of two instructors. Preschool staff members have experience in Early Childhood Education and attend preschool teaching workshops yearly. All are trained in CPR. As directed by the Episcopal Church Diocese, each staff member has completed the course "Safeguarding God's Children". Our dedicated staff views teaching little ones as an extension of ministry.

### Where we learn and play...

Classes are held in the classrooms specifically designed for preschool aged children. Children attend Music and Movement activities, Preschool Chapel for 2, 3, 4, and 5 year olds, and Spanish is taught to 4 and 5 year olds. Two shaded and gated playgrounds are utilized daily.



### Getting off on the right foot...

The first five years of a child's life form a foundation for later development. St. David's Preschool offers a rich curriculum within a Christian environment. Children are given a variety of learning, play, and developmental activities every day. The teachers share these activities with parents on the weekly lesson plans. The teachers make learning fun! A detailed evaluation of progress is given to each child's parent during conferences in February and again in May.

### Signing up...

St. David's Preschool is a 9 month program that runs from end of August to mid-May. It loosely follows the Fulton County School Calendar for days off and holidays. It is encouraged that anyone interested in having a child attend St. David's Preschool contact the office for a visit. The director will give a tour, answer questions, and inform of any current openings. Registration begins in February.

### Keeping it safe...

When St. David's opened a nursery school in 1969, it was the desire to offer a quality preschool program in a safe environment. The facility is equipped with safe, age-appropriate toys and equipment that is clean and well maintained. The building is locked during school hours and each classroom is wired with an intercom to the director's office. Entry and hallways, parking lots and playgrounds are under video surveillance. The teachers and staff are screened before employment and trained to properly work with young children.

### What's special about this place?

Besides offering a quality program, there are some extra offerings that make the experience even better!

**COVID-19** awareness and safety protocols are in place to uphold CDC and Bright from the Start school guidelines. Children are kept in classroom "pods" to allow for contact tracing and limited exposure to others. Teachers are in touch weekly with parents via website and virtual meetings to inform and share preschool moments remotely. The preschool wing is segregated from other areas of the church with restricted access. Sanitizing practices are used in the classroom, bathrooms, hallways, common areas, and playgrounds.

**Carpool** drop off and pick up is a convenient and safe way for our preschool students get started with their school day and have them efficiently returned when the preschool day is over.

**Allergy Awareness:** Teachers are provided with information on children's allergies. The preschool provides and serves only NUT FREE and allergy sensitive snacks on the premises.

**Hands on Learning** takes place each day with age appropriate lessons and activities. Children interact with classmates throughout the morning.

**Plans are in place for Remote Learning** should there be a need to turn to remote learning, the preschool teachers are able to transition from classroom teaching to distance with useful applications that are used from the start of preschool. Families will be able to connect back with lessons through posted activities and live sessions that can be seen on a device or computer.


