

**7:45 a.m.** service will begin by gathering together on the front steps of Harrison Hall for the Liturgy of the Palms and process into the church together.




# Join Us for Pickleball Tuesdays, 6:30-8:30 p.m.

#### Why do we celebrate Children's Day?

Children's Day dates back to the 1950s, when the United Nations General Assembly recommended that each country establish a Universal Children's Day to promote the well-being of children. By then, Mexico had already designated April 31st as Children's Day, as agreed upon by the National Commission on Human Rights.

The purpose of this day is to recognize and promote children's rights, as well as highlight the importance of their well-being and development. Every child is born with the right to a healthy start in life, an education, a safe childhood, and all the basic opportunities that lead to a productive and prosperous adulthood.

Beyond gifts or recreational activities, this day is an opportunity to remember that children's rights are a shared responsibility and that, by celebrating them, we recognize their importance in the present and their fundamental role in the future of each country.
