

Palm **Sunday**


7:45 a.m. service will begin by gathering together on the front steps of Harrison Hall for the Liturgy of the Palms and process into the church together.

From the Rector: Supporting Our Preschool

For many decades, St. David's preschool has had extraordinary leadership in its directors, its staff, its board, and its church family. That has been of great benefit to us, especially over the last decade or so, as the preschool began to experience headwinds of demographic change in our immediate surroundings.

Attendance in our local elementary schools has declined significantly over the last 10-12 years. Population centers for families with young children, who can afford to pay full tuition have moved further from us. Parents seeking a half-day, religious-affiliated schools for early childhood education are fewer than they once were. The free Georgia Pre-K program is benefiting families who were otherwise served by organizations like ours.

We have great leadership in place to adapt to these challenges, and a vestry that has

been supportive of their efforts to adapt. These bodies need your help to rebuild the strength of our school. We know you care about our school, our students and their families. Please hold them in your prayers.

Six Mercies: Serving Our Community

The symbol for the Six Mercies ministry is an anchor. The anchor stands for hope. We founded the ministry based on the six mercies in Matthew – feed the hungry, ransom the captive, bury the dead, shelter the stranger, comfort the sick and cloth the naked.

Each Monday, 1:00-3:00 p.m., we open our doors to those in our community that are in need of assistance. We interview each one to determine the need and try to bring hope to all that come. We have a team of two during each time period. We dispense a gift card, Marta card, toiletry kit and snack kit. The volunteer determines which items are needed based on the interview.



Please consider joining our group! We are flexible and will work with you on hours. If you are not able to volunteer on Mondays, we need volunteers to help us in many other ways. You are welcome to be with us on Mondays to discern if this is a way you would like to serve.




