

### **Palm Sunday Gospel Drama**

As many will recall, the Gospel lesson for Palm Sunday is read as a multi-person narrative for key persons mentioned in the lesson, including lines spoken by the entire congregation (e.g., "Crucify Him!"). This year we're going to present the Gospel lesson as a "Drama of the Word." We will dramatically present the story from the Gospel of Luke about the events of the Last Supper, Jesus' betrayal and arrest in the Garden of Gethsemane, His appearance before the chief priests and Pilate, and

His crucifixion. There's ample opportunity for drama in those scenes! If you would enjoy taking part in such a dramatic presentation, we'd like to hear from you.

And to prepare for the drama they also must be committed, during the Sunday adult formation time (10:15-11:00 a.m.), to attend for instruction and rehearsal with a person well-trained in the thespian arts. 


# New Beginnings February 18-March 2, Camp Mikell
